The NSPCC is the UK's leading charity fighting to end child abuse. For 140 years they have been campaigning for and creating change, in schools, online and in local communities through services such as Childline, Helpline and their school's Speak out and Stay Safe programme. During the day all classes will be walking / running / hopping / skipping around our school field to complete a mile while raising money for this valuable charity.
