## Summer Challenge 2025

All your child needs to do is take an amazing photograph and submit it to the competition in one of three categories. They are:

### Nature

### Holidays / Days Out

### Reading

All children who submit a photograph will start the year with one of my Headteacher Awards and the top photograph in each category will be printed onto canvas and displayed permanently in school.

### Rules

The photography needs to not have any recognisable people in it (distant shots of people are fine).

Photographs can be taken on any photographic device e.g. a parent's phone, a tablet, digital camera or even an old school camera with a film.

All entries will need to be submitted by Friday 5 September.

Children can enter all three categories.

Only one entry per category.

The best photograph in each category as chosen by me and the senior leadership team will be printed onto canvas for display. All photographs will be uploaded to one of three Padlets (an online collaborative resource) for sharing and producing a slideshow.

When submitting your child's photo, please include their first name and class in the caption. Photographs submitted via Padlet will only appear once they have been approved so if it does not appear straightaway, please be patient.
