Headteacher's Comment:

Welcome back!

I hope that everyone has had a fantastic summer break and is ready for another exciting year at Larchwood. Before I talk about the coming year I just wanted to say a huge well done to everyone who took part in the Larchwood Summer Challenge and either posted on Twitter (now called X) or sent things in. The response was huge and I have given out over 170 Headteacher Awards this week. Seeing how much fun people were having or reading about it on postcards was brilliant. Special awards for those that did all 10 challenges will be given out next week.

You will also recall that over the summer the hall roof was being replaced as the final part of the roof upgrade. The work was scheduled to continue into the new term ever so slightly, but despite the weather not being the best, the roofers worked extremely hard and completed the work early. We now have a roof fit for the future and a new ceiling in the hall. It looks fantastic.

The term has started really well. Staff had two training days on Monday and Tuesday. On Monday we did some training on teaching and learning and our curriculum ready for the coming year. On Tuesday we were joined by the staff from Hogarth Primary who are now part of the Discovery Educational Trust (DET) and staff from Kelvedon Hatch Community Primary School, who will become part of DET shortly. The morning was spent talking about being in the Trust with Mr Duff and then all staff received valuable safeguarding training.

Safeguarding children is one of our key responsibilities and this is why schools have training on it every year. It is so important. As part of the training we talked about our filtering and monitoring systems for using IT in school and I will update you on this later in the term.

We also had our first group of Reception children start on Thursday - welcome to you. All children are looking smart and are already working hard. A highlight of the week was seeing everyone together in assembly on Wednesday afternoon.
