Mr Bowsher's Headteacher Comment:

Like all weeks at Larchwood, there has once again been lots of learning taking place alongside plenty of enjoyment. Our Senior Leadership Team have spent time this week watching learning across all classes, with a particular focus on how well all children are actively engaged and how knowledge and language skills are being developed. Seeing our skilled teachers and delivering lessons that fully immerse children in their learning and develop their language is always a joy.

As well as these visits, we also had the pleasure of speaking to some of our Year 2 children about their learning in history and geography. It was fantastic to hear them confidently recount their work on topics such as Pompeii and describe the role of archaeologists in uncovering the past. Their enthusiasm and recall showed just how much they enjoy their learning.

On Tuesday, we welcomed some staff and residents from Howard Lodge, our local care home, who very generously donated new resources for the room we use to support some of our SEND children. This lovely connection came about thanks to two of our pupils, Brodey and Mia, who volunteer at Howard Lodge and spoke proudly about our school – thank you.

Tuesday was also a busy day for music across the school. Year 2 and Year 6 took part in music workshops organised through the Essex Music Service. Year 6 combined their computing programming skills with music composition, while Year 2 explored an exciting crossover of computing, music and science by composing music using electrical circuits and iPads. After half term, even more musical opportunities await, with our choir heading to the O2 to sing as part of Young Voices and piano lessons starting for some of our Year 4 and 5 children.

Today Don Rae was back with us for a day of Chinese New Year themed dancing and fun with Year 1 and 2.

And now some events coming up. Many of you will remember last year's hugely popular 'Come Dine With Me' events, where adults joined their children for lunch. With 40–50 adults attending each session, we are delighted to be running these again. The first dates are listed below.
