Headteacher's Comment:

Children having an understanding of the world around them is one of the six aims of our curriculum. I mention this because three of our year groups are currently undertaking blocks of learning in geography. Year 4 are studying the UK, Year 5 are learning about the Americas and Year 6 are learning about Asia with a focus on Japan and China. (I'll be talking to them about the trip to our link school in China that we made in 2019). Later in the term Year 1 learn about the local area and Year 2 learn about Australia. Year 3 have been learning about Africa while in Reception, children are constantly developing an understanding of the world around them.

Of course, understanding the world around them isn't just learning about places in other countries. It is taught in history, PSHCE, French, English, maths, art and PE etc. Having visitors into school, going on trips and reading all help. In fact, I'd say reading is one of the most important things you can do to develop that understanding of the world around you. That is why we read so much in school and we expect children to read every day and develop a love of reading. READ, READ, READ! It really helps.
