# **Headteacher's Comment:**

Safeguarding children from harm is a massive part of a school's role. All staff at Larchwood receive safeguarding training throughout the year and when a school is inspected safeguarding will be one of the first things that Ofsted will look at to make sure it is effective. As I'm sure you are aware Mrs Jaycock is our Designated Safeguarding Lead (DSL) and Mr Sumner, Mrs Belle and myself are also part of the team.

The work we do to make children aware of how to keep safe and how to report any concerns is extensive. An example that many of you will be familiar with is the NSPCC Pants song which I'm sure you will have heard your child singing at some point. We also do lots of work around online safety and how to keep yourself safe online. Ten years ago, this would have meant when you were online on a computer, but now most children are online using phones, tablets or game consoles.

As a parent it can be mind boggling the number of apps and games children play, especially when children get towards the end of primary school and they are allowed a phone. There is lots of content out there that we wouldn't want our children to see and we want them to behave responsibly when using devices to communicate. The key thing is to educate children on what is appropriate and what is not. If a child sees something online they don't like and and tells you and your first reaction is to take the device away or ban it, don't be surprised if they don't tell you again. The key thing is to educate them about what to do if it happens.

In the last few weeks there has been a lot on social media about a Netflix show called Squid Game. The title sounds innocent enough and for a young person this sounds like something fun. For those of you not aware it is a 15 age rated show that is 100% not appropriate for children in any shape or form. However, there are videos on TikTok that refer to it, the children's game Roblox has versions people have made called Squid Game and when you turn on Netflix sometimes the trailer may play. I'm not advocating you talking about this TV show with your children, but you can see as parents how easy it is to find references to it.

A recent trend on TikTok for secondary school aged children is to steal things from school. Children will definitely see videos on there if they search for it. Both of these examples are why it is important to teach children what to do if they see something they don't like online.

To help you as parents become more aware of some of the apps and games children will be wanting to use, Miss Beard, who is responsible for online safety at Larchwood, will be sending out some information every Tuesday for the rest of term in what we are calling 'Tech Tuesday'. Hopefully this will be informative and will help you to keep your child safe online.
