Headteacher's Comment:

Previously in News and Views I have talked about the aims of our curriculum. There are opportunities to develop each of these daily in class and around school. Each teacher leads one of the subjects we teach and are experts at this. They work with the other staff to ensure that we get the best outcomes for our children and that they get to have a wealth of experiences. To give you a flavour of this I thought I would share a little bit about different subjects each week.

I was talking with Miss Charlesworth earlier in the week about music which she leads. She makes sure that children get plenty of opportunities, for example, she leads the choir and takes our weekly singing assembly. She also makes sure that children get to experience different music every day. This is done through 'Music of the Month' in assembly. We always start assembly by singing one of the songs that we have learnt and finish by finding out a little bit about the day's music and then develop our listening skills as we hear it when we leave. In previous months we have listened to music related to black history, music from the romantic era, the baroque era, the medieval era, the renaissance era, music from around the world, music from film and this month, music related to instruments of the orchestra. Today we listened to 'Londonderry Air' which was played with instruments from the brass family. I'm sure the children can tell you which instruments those are.
