# **Headteacher's Comment:**

Educational visits play an important part of a child's education. As adults we often remember our school trips a lot more than some of the other things we did at school. I have very clear memories of mine. Educational visits provide an opportunity to enhance the learning we have done in the classroom and take it outside or to other venues. It also gives children the opportunity to experience new things.
