## **Headteacher's Comment:**

This week has been Year 6's transition week. This means that all of our Year 6s have spent 1 or 2 days at their new secondary schools getting ready for Year 7. You will all remember the transition mornings your children had for Reception when they started Larchwood and these take place again in a couple of weeks. But what about our current children - how do we get them ready for next year?

Well they find out their new teacher on 14th July when the reports come out. Then on Monday 17th we have our Celebration evening where you come and visit the school to look at your child's work, classroom and even visit the new classroom and meet the new teacher informally. Finally, on Tuesday 18th July children spend the morning with their new teacher in their new classroom ready for September. Starting the year is always tricky, but we find this transition period helps all children, from Reception to Year 7.

#### **Building Work**

You may have seen in the news this week that schools are finding it increasingly difficult to fund improvements to buildings. We are fortunate at Larchwood that our buildings are generally in good shape and Mr Doug and the cleaners work hard to keep them looking good. We are also fortunate to have the Discovery Educational Trust (DET) to help us gain additional funding for improvements.

This summer we will be having the hall roof replaced. This is part of the same work to replace the roof in the original part of the school last summer. The curved section of the hall roof is made of a material that is straw based and it clearly needs improving. Work starts on Saturday 22<sup>nd</sup> July continuing through to the start of next term. Apart from losing a small part of the playground in September for a couple of weeks we don't expect it to impact the running of the school.

We have also been able to secure funding for work on our heating and water delivery systems the following year. Basically, all the pipes around the school will be replaced and the heating system will have a new control panel. This is going to help make the school more energy efficient.

Overall the DET has managed to secure almost £500,000 specifically for these projects.

#### **Governor Visit**

On Monday Governors, Lisa Wenham and Gillian Walsh conducted a joint visit. This was for both Safeguarding and Health & Safety.

A group of children from Year 2 up to Year 6 were given a map to view of the school. They were asked about the inside areas and outside areas of the school. This was to see where their fun, safe, don't like and scary places were.

All the children thought hard about this and gave clear, concise answers. They said that they

At the end of the morning the Governors met with myself, showing me the results, which meant we could highlight any problems. The full results will be discussed at the next full Governors meeting in July.
