Headteacher's Comment:

News and Views always has a section on attendance. We have high expectations of attendance and the national average is 96%. Our current school figure is currently well over 97% which is great. Being at school regularly makes a huge difference to how children do in their school career and being absent frequently means children are going to get lower qualifications when they eventually leave school. We will have learning going on right up to the final day of term on Friday 18th December and after the lockdown last academic year, it all counts. Even if children are at home self-isolating learning is still being set for them. Well done to everyone who continues to come to school every day, it makes a difference

At this point it is also worth reminding people that children need to be in school by 8:45am. After this time children are late and will be missing learning. It will mean adults are having to come onto the school site unnecessarily. Please be on time.

The other thing we always have on News and Views is our reading figures. Last week we had 8 classes that all read at least 4 times. This was a record. Mr Duff even messaged me to say how pleased he was to see this. Well done. This week there are only 2 classes getting a certificate for reading at least 4 times. It needs to be at least 8 classes (13 is the aim) each and every week.

This will give you a good indication of how your child is progressing since lockdown, where they are working now and what their attendance is.
