Homework

We have a very simple policy around homework at Larchwood. There are 2 things to do. Read with your child every day and learn number facts or times tables. These things little and often mean children leave Larchwood having mastered the basic skills. Not doing these means they are at a disadvantage. One of the great ways to learn times tables is to use Times Tables Rock Stars. This is used with children from Year 3 and the expectation is that Year 3 to 5 (Year 6 have different things to do) go online and use this 3 times a week. If you can't get online, there are paper copies children can take home, but we do expect them to be doing it.
