## Home Learning Years 1 to 6 – January 2021

As stated in our letter of 31<sup>st</sup> December 2020 the remote learning for children will be set on Microsoft Teams for all children from Year 1 up to Year 6. It is expected that all children do this work.

Whilst learning at home, children will have 4 lessons per day plus handwriting.

The expected time home learning should take is approximately 3 hours on average. Obviously older children will be able to cope with this amount more than some of the younger children. The lessons will be:

- a White Rose maths video, activity and answers
- a live lesson for English plus an accompanying activity. The live lesson will last for about 30 minutes. The lesson will be recorded and will appear in the Class Teams account so those children unable to log in live will be able to watch the video and do the work at a later time. All live lessons for English will take place at **9:00am** except for **6PA** when it will be at **10:10am** and **4K** when it will be at **11:30am**.
- a video for the foundation lessons plus an activity.
- a phonics activity for Year 1 and 2 or a reading activity for Years 3 to 6.
- a daily handwriting activity for Year 1 and 2 and handwriting for Years 3 to 6 three times a week.

It is important for you to arrange your daily timetable so that it is suitable for your own personal circumstances. However, if you would like to have some structure to your day, below is a rough timetable as it would be in school.

**9:00am** - English live lesson (except 6PA and 4K)

**10:00am - Break**

**10:10am** - Maths lesson (except 6PA and 4K)

**11:15am - Break**

**11:25am** - Foundation lesson

**12:30pm - Lunch**

**1:30pm** - Phonics/reading activity

**2:00pm** - No lesson for this on Teams but we advise some physical activity and activities of your choice

**3:00 - Finish for the day**

Teachers will be checking Teams throughout the day to give feedback to those children who have completed work. They will also be in school teaching critical worker children. The videos and activities for the next day will be uploaded to Teams so that when children log on in the morning, they will have everything they need for the day.
