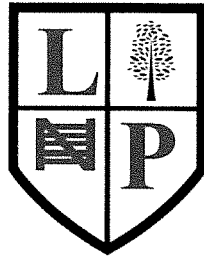

Swimming lessons at the Brentwood Centre

Dear Parents/Carers

Swimming sessions will commence for Year 3 children next week and will be split into the following two sessions:

Class 3A (Mrs Adcock) - Mondays – 11.30am to 12.00pm (first session **Monday 9th September**)

Class 3B (Miss Beard) - Tuesdays - 10.30am to 11.00am (first session **Tuesday 10th September**)

Swimming is a compulsory part of the school PE curriculum which all children are expected to participate in. Being able to swim is a valuable skill for life and also an enjoyable experience.

If your child is unable to participate for medical reasons then please provide a doctor's letter stating the reason. If they are unwell, due to a bad cold or similar, and need to miss a week, then please send them to school at the normal time with a note. Children not swimming will work in another class during this time.

We are asking for a contribution of £32 for 13 weeks towards the cost of the swimming lessons. This represents good value for money. Unfortunately we cannot give refunds if your child misses a session as the pool and instructors are booked and paid for in advance.

Arrangements for the Sessions

Swimwear:

One piece costumes only – no bikinis
Trunks/shorts fitted not baggy

All children to wear a swimming hat which must be purchased in advance. These are available from the Brentwood Centre at £3.50 each.

The class teacher and a learning support assistant (LSA) will walk the children to and from the Brentwood Centre.

You are welcome to watch from the viewing area but please do not interfere with the lessons.
